A written test will be scheduled and after successful completion, the Golden Valley Fire District will contact candidates and invite them to continue to participate in other stages of the department selection process.

Necessary Certifications:

- Arizona Firefighter 1 & 2 (or equivalent)
- Valid Arizona State/National Registry Paramedic Certification
- Valid Arizona State/National Registry EMT Certification
- Valid Driver's License within applicant's state of residence

Felony, Criminal Activity Disqualifiers:

- No Felony Convictions in last 10 years
- No DUI Convictions last 5 years
- No drug use arrest or conviction of illegal substances prior 5 years

Driving Disqualifiers:

- Poor driving record based on Class A and Class B violations
- Suspension or revocation of driver's license in last 5 years

Selection Process:

Those applicants who successfully pass the examination process shall be placed on an eligibility list. The top candidates chosen will be called for an internal oral board examination.

- Submit application by established deadline.
- Passing score of entry level written exam. (100 point maximum)
- Oral Interview (150 points maximum)
- Fire Chief's Interview (100 points maximum)
- Comprehensive Resume (180 points maximum)
- Pass a Fitness for Duty Physical and Drug Screening
- Current Volunteer Firefighters and Veterans preference points

Note: Paramedics without firefighter certificates will have to agree to attend the first available firefighter academy in the area after being hired.
